

Non – Traditional Scholarship Guidelines

One \$750.00 will be awarded to an eligible student returning to a University, Vocational, or Technical College after spending three years in the work place or raising a family.

One applicant will be chosen in a random drawing at our Annual Meeting, from all of the completed and verified applications received for the scholarships.

Qualifications for the scholarship are:

1. The applicant or their spouse must be a member of Vernon Electric Cooperative and a bona fide resident of the cooperative.
2. The applicant must be in “good standing” with Vernon Electric Cooperative.
3. The recipient must have maintained at least a 2.0 or better grade point average during their current quarter or semester of post secondary education.
4. The application must be filled out and returned to the Vernon Electric Cooperative office by 4:30 p.m. on the second Wednesday in March.
5. The recipient must be enrolled in a course of study leading to an associate’s or bachelor’s degree.
6. The Non-Traditional Scholarship will be limited to a one-time award. After receiving a scholarship, the individual will not be eligible for future awards.
7. The recipients will be chosen in a random drawing at the Annual Meeting. The applicant or applicant’s spouse **MUST BE PRESENT AT THE ANNUAL MEETING.** If the applicant or applicant’s spouse is not present, the applicant will not receive the scholarship should his/her name be drawn. Instead, a new name will be drawn until the scholarship can be awarded to an applicant meeting the attendance requirements.

Disbursement of scholarships will be awarded after all qualifications are met and with receipt of transcripts and verification of enrollment from eligible recipient.
