

Vernon Electric Cooperative allows members of the Cooperative to sell excess energy from their renewable energy system. There is a one-time service charge of \$500 + tax for interconnection setup.

## Distributed Generation Pre-Interconnection Checklist For Member Use (20 KW system or less)

_	Application completed and returned to Cooperative
	Meeting at location with VEC Field Technician to inspect existing service equipment
	Verified there are no subtractive (sub) meters (i.e. Dual Fuel, Heat Storage, Grain Drying) on account
	Interconnection Agreement
	☐ Signed and returned to Cooperative
	☐ Cooperative signed and returned to member before inspection and anti-islanding test
	Certificate of Insurance provided to Cooperative - \$300,000 minimum liability with 30-day cancellation
	notification to Cooperative
	Inverter/Equipment Certification of UL 1741 Compliance documentation submitted
	Equipment Specifications submitted
	Interconnection Line-Diagram submitted
	\$500 + tax paid for interconnection services
	Wiring affidavit signed by electrician and returned to Cooperative
	Apply for rebate*

\*REBATES: Vernon Electric is offering a rebate for net-metered, new solar photovoltaic installations on Vernon Electric lines of \$250 per KW of installed capacity, up to \$750 maximum. This rebate is evaluated annually (12/31) and could change. To submit for a rebate please supply copies of paid invoices for labor and equipment. Solar panels must have been purchased within 6 months of installation.

NOTE: System shall not be energized to back-feed grid until anti-islanding test is performed by Vernon Electric personnel.
