To make the event even more exciting, members who stopped by our booth had the chance to win a \$25 bill credit. Congratulations to this year's lucky winners:





#### MAIL SERVICE DELAYS IMPACTING PAYMENTS

We want to make members aware of recent mail service issues which have caused delays in the delivery of payments sent to Vernon Electric. While we know the mail system has always been a trusted way to send and receive payments, we've seen an increase in delays that are beyond our control.

- Automatic Bank Draft: Set up recurring payments that are drafted directly from your account each month.
- Online Payments: Use SmartHub to quickly and securely pay your bill online.
- In-Person Payments: Stop by our office or use our drop box for added peace of mind.
